
Please put your child's first and last name on all belongings including:

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# **Credit/Refund Policy for Camp**

All cancellations **must be made in writing** and include the date sent, the dates being cancelled, a brief explanation and a parent/guardian signature.

To receive a full refund you must cancel Monday the week prior to the scheduled week.

 For 50% refund you must cancel by Thursday the week prior to the scheduled week

# **Camp Rules**

- Be kind to others
- Do not push, shove, hit, bite, scratch or grab another participant
- Listen to instructions when given by staff and/or Site director
- No Electronics other than communication devices allowed in camp- The Arc is not responsible for lost personal items.

## **Transportation**

- The Arc does not provide transportation for campers.
- Campers must be dropped off and picked up at camp site.
- To ensure the safety of our campers, we require a list of names and contact information of who may pick your child up.
- Campers will only be allowed to be picked up by those on the approved list.
